



Pet Policy

I believe that children can learn a lot from having contact with animals; however certain procedures must be followed to ensure the safety of the children;

- Children are encouraged to treat all animals with respect, learning how to handle them correctly.
- Children must wash their hands after any contact with animals and understand the reasoning behind this.
- Children are taught that not all animals are child friendly and that they should always check with the animal's owner before attempting to stroke or handle them.
- Food for our pets is stored safely away from the children's reach
- A high standard of hygiene is followed, with careful thought given to the placing of the feeding and drink bowls of dogs and other animals.
- The garden is checked every morning, before the children are permitted outside to play, to ensure that no animal has fouled it.
